- This Good practice relates to supporting a comprehensive Care Planning Process to ensure each Patients needs are met within Inpatient services.



- The Inpatient Care Planning process focuses on assessment, planning, implementation and evaluation of care within the Patients living environment.



- The Inpatient Care Planning process looks to dovetail with one Multidisciplinary Care Plan which supports Multidisciplinary team work.



- The process encourages and respects patient's wishes, human rights, and Mental Capacity Act principles and encourages thought of one Patients journey within an NHS facility.



- In summary the process looks to have one Care Planning folder incorporating assessment, planning, implementation and evaluation records which provide a quality circle of intervention.



- The process looks to balance physical and psychological needs focused on Health care.



- The process relies on Partnership working between Patients and Carers and Best interest processes for anyone who lacks capacity in terms of care provided.



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
