The Isle of Man Department of Health and Social Care has commissioned WMQRS to undertake a rolling programme of external, independent quality assurance of its health services. This flier gives an update on the reviews completed and the plan of future visits.

There are some changes to the scope of the programme, in particular, screening services are now included and reviews of some services have been grouped together.



The aims of this work are:

- a. To provide an assessment of the quality of care provided to Manx patients.
- b. To help providers of healthcare to fulfil their duty of quality
- c. To help drive improvements in quality and efficiency, and to spread innovation and good practice
- d. To identify areas where services are in need of improvement, with special reference to any areas in which there is an unacceptable risk to patient and/or staff safety.
- e. To comment upon the suitability, or otherwise, of services currently provided in the Isle of Man
